

# No single country provides the conditions to both support children to live healthy lives today and provide an environment fit for their future



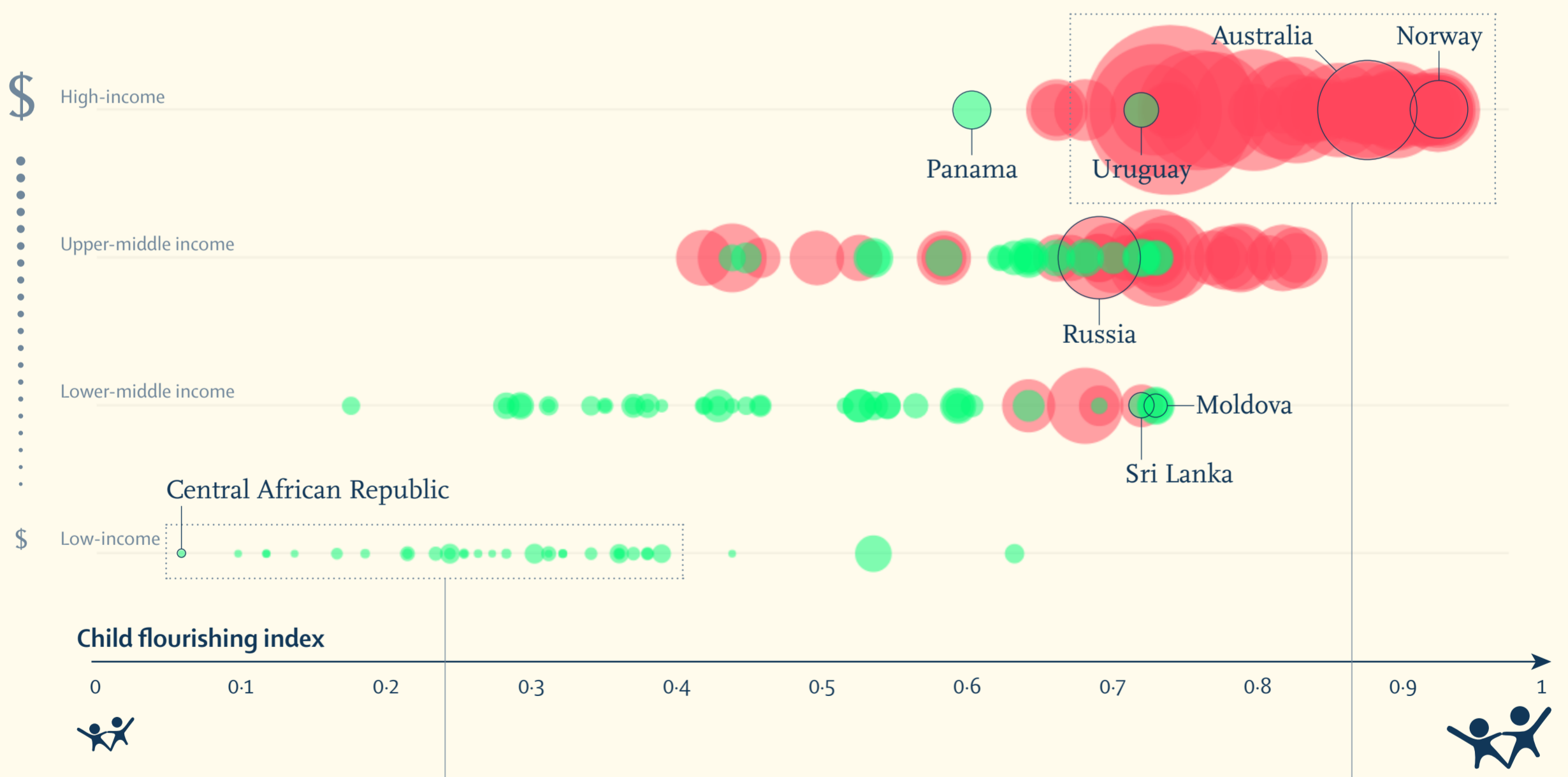
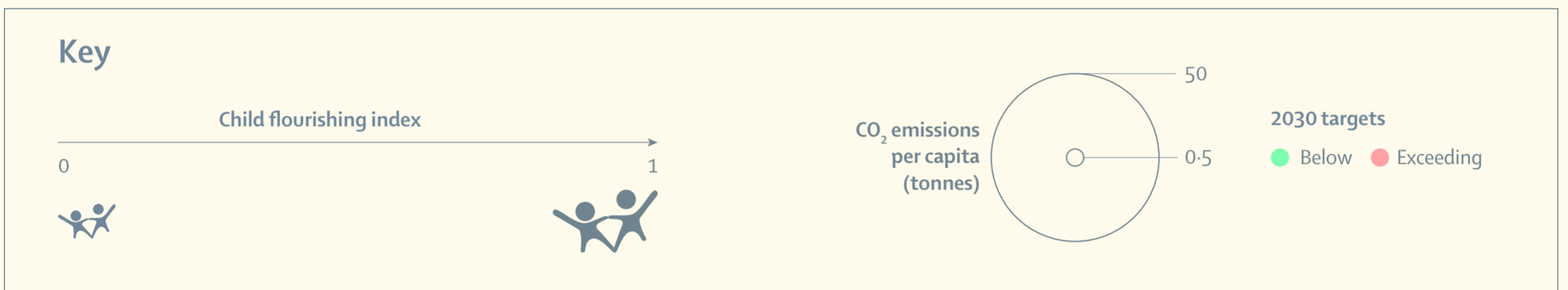
## Child flourishing index

The index combines survive and thrive metrics. Countries with high scores offer children the best start in life.



## Carbon emissions

Excess CO<sub>2</sub> emissions relative to 2030 targets reflect a country's threat to future children.



The poorest countries have further to go towards supporting healthy lives for children today, but report among the lowest CO<sub>2</sub> emissions per capita.

No country performs well across all measures, but some, such as **Moldova** and **Sri Lanka**, are on track to beat the 2030 emissions targets while also being in the top 40–80 countries on child flourishing measures.

Wealthier countries support healthier lives for children today, but threaten the future of all children through CO<sub>2</sub> pollution.
